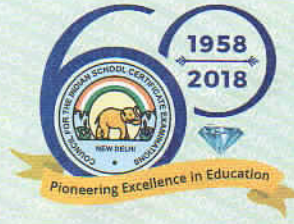

Awards and conditions for awards:
